NMC2 (also referred to as site collection) is the standardized, unclassified scheduling and tracking system for all nuclear weapons maintenance. Additionally, it allows enterprise collaboration across MAJCOMs, DTRA, and USSTRATCOM. DAWSON manages the composition of over 300 Nuclear Enterprise permission groups comprised of over 13,000 individual users.

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
